- Assist with teaching of academic music lessons. There may be the opportunity to take classes for those interested in this area of personal development
- Offer other assistance as required to support the work of the music department including the co-curricular programme
- To be fully involved with the busy life of a boarding school, to include boarding and other supervisory duties, sport and/or activities
- To work with the local community churches and provide musical support in services at key times of the year
